Clothespin Garden Monster

Materials

- clothespin
- Black marker/crayon/another utensil
- Paint/marker/crayon (to color your clothespin)
- White paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick



Instructions

1. Color your clothespin* with a medium of your choice (let dry if you use paint).



*it might be easier to color your clothespin if you take it apart and put it back together when you've finished coloring. Ask an adult for help! See the image below.



2. Use your scissor to cut out two small circles and two small triangles from the white paper. The circles are for the eyes, the triangles are the fangs.



3. Decorate the eyes by drawing a dot in the middle of each circle.



4. Paste an eye on each side of the clothespin



5. Paste a fang on each side of the clothespin.



6. You're all done! You can continue to decorate your garden monster with more fangs or maybe even some wings and a tail. Use the garden monster to play with or put it to work labeling your plants!
