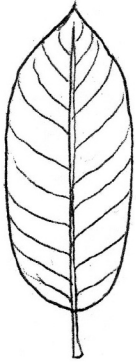
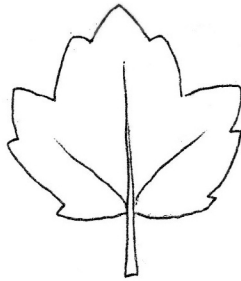


Tree Explorer

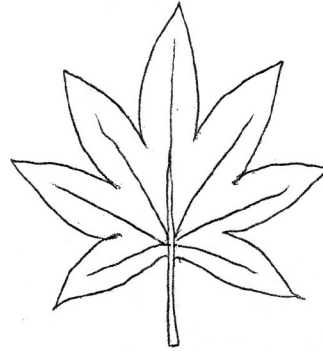

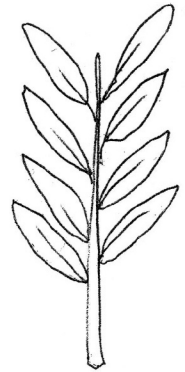
Cucumber Maple



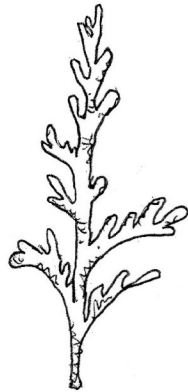
Red Maple



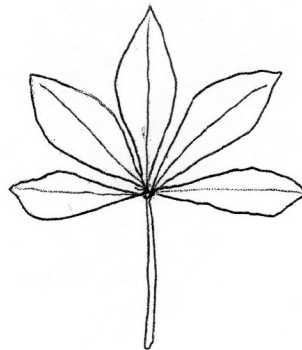
Japanese Maple



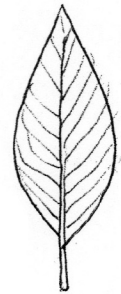

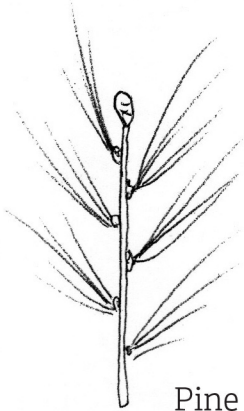
