

Blind Man's Wand

About: Blind Man's Wand is similar to Blind Man's Buff where one player would be blindfolded and chase the others. Blind Man's Buff can be traced back to ancient Greece. Blind Man's Wand however is a version played in the 1800's. It is different in that it is played without the chasing and tagging. Test your observation and disguise skills with this game!

Number of Players: At least 3

Other Supplies: a stick like object/ wooden spoon to use as the wand, a blindfold

Instructions:

1. Choose a player to be your blind man
2. The blind man will stand in the middle of the other players wearing a blindfold and holding the wand.
3. The blind man will hold the end of the wand out for one of the other players to hold.
4. Then, the blind man will ask the player holding the wand 3 questions about him/her self.
5. The person can disguise their voice to make it difficult for the blind man to guess who they are.
6. The blind man is forbidden to ask who you are but if he/ she does, you can answer with a pretend name.
7. Whoever's identity is discovered last wins!
