

Decorative Bowl/ Container

Materials:

- Small glass/ceramic bowl, jar, vase etc.
- Mod podge (you can also use craft/tacky glue mixed with some water)
- Decorative napkin/paper towel (if you do not have a decorative kind, draw a design on a plain white one)
- Paintbrush



Instructions

1. Choose a vessel to decorate. This can include old mason jars, finger bowls, and even flowerpots. The sky is the limit, however, try not to use something you will need to wash too often.



2. Tear up your napkin into pieces (approx. 1")



3. With your paint brush, generously add some mod podge (or glue/water mixture) to your item.



4. Take one of the napkin pieces and pat it onto the sticky surface.



5. Take another generous amount of your glue and brush it on the surface of the napkin that is now stuck to your item, until it is totally covered.



6. Continue Steps 3.- 5. Until the outside is completely covered*.

*DO NOT decorate the inside or bottom of your bowl, jar, etc. Keep the glue away from these areas.

7. It might be helpful to put your vessel upside-down over top of a smaller one (as seen below) in order to see hard to reach areas toward the bottom.



8. Your creation will take about 30 minutes to dry completely, depending on how much glue you used. Once its dry, use it to hold anything you like!
